 - d. Valid Degrees/Certificates/Testimonials on Qualifications and Trainings (a duly attested photocopy of each).
 - e. Work Experience Certificate (a duly attested photocopy).
 - f. Physical and mental health or fitness certificate from the qualified medical practitioners.
 - g. Domicile Certificate and Permanent Residence Certificate (PRC) (a duly attested photocopy of each).
 - h. Character Certificate / Police Verification Report (in original).

 - j. Bank *Challan* of Prescribed Deposit of Application Processing Fee (in original), made in advance of the application's submission to the Licencing Authority.
 - k. Certificate of Required Mineral's Occurrence/Presence (in original).
 - l. Proof of Financial Resources (a duly attested photocopy).
 - m. Proof of Technical Resources (a duly attested photocopy).
 - n. Geological Report (in original).
 - o. A qualified/certified surveyor's location plan or map/drawing of the area requested for mining concession (in original).
 - p. Verification report by the authorised Survey and Drawing Officer (SDO) of the Mines and Mineral Development Department (M&MDD) on the party's submitted qualified/certified surveyor's location plan or map/drawing of the area requested for mining concession (in original).
 - q. Report by the concerned Mineral Development Officer (MDO) of the M&MDD on the required mineral's deposits' estimated quantity and quality, duly verified by the Director (Exploration) of the M&MDD (in original).
 - r. Feasibility Study Report (in original).
 - s. Business, Investment, Mining Work and Production Plans (in original).
 - t. Environmental Report (in original).
 - u. Field Officers' report on conduct of the applicant(s) as holder(s) of other mining concession(s) at present and/or in the past, if any.
